HI-LINE Resource Guide

JG RESEARCH AND EVALUATION

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BACKGROUND

The Montana Primary Care Association, in collaboration with the Montana Hospital Association, and support from JG Research and Evaluation (JGRE), completed an inventory of behavioral health services and recovery supports for individuals who misuse opioids (Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) and/or illicit use) within the 11 counties that constitute the Montana Hi-Line. These include the counties of: Glacier, Toole, Hill, Blaine, Phillips, Valley, Daniels, Sheridan, McCone, Richland, and Roosevelt, in addition to the surrounding counties of Pondera, Liberty, and Dawson.

The inventory documents are in a dynamic format, allowing for maintenance of the inventory over time, ensuring that the resource inventory can continue to be of value to practitioners in the region after the conclusion of the project period. The goals of the project are:

- Identify resources that can be supports to individuals misuse opioids (Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) and/or illicit use) within a hospital setting along the Hi-Line
- Identify resources that support recovery for individuals with misuse opioids along the Hi-Line.

DATA APPROACH

SECONDARY DATA

JGRE's approach was to look at existing Secondary datasets and create an inventory of resources for individuals who misuse opioids along the Hi-Line. The second datasets JGRE used included:

- Board of Behavioral Health Licensing Data
- National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services
- SAMHSA Treatment Locator
- Existing resource guides and inventories NAMI, LAC, others to be identified

PRIMARY **D**ATA

At this point, JGRE staff identified gaps in the data and developed a survey to gather additional data from community stakeholders along the Hi-Line to complete the inventory. The primary data collection methods included:

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SERVICES DEFINITIONS

- **PREVENTION SERVICES** Can include but are not limited to interagency coalitions/taskforces that address opioid use, Prevention Specialists, community education/training programs such as Mental Health First Aid and QPR, etc.
- NALOXONE AVAILABILITY Can include but are not limited to Opioid Overdose Response Teams, naloxone (Narcan) access for first responders or community members, naloxone take home kits, etc.
- SYRINGE EXCHANGE Can include but are not limited to syringe exchanges or other harm reduction efforts for individuals who misuse opioids.
- ▲ Drug DISPOSAL LOCATIONS Can include but are not limited to drug disposal locations or other medication take back events.
- ◆ MEDICAL SUPPORTS Can include but are not limited to medical providers who treat patients with OUD (Opioid Use Disorder), prescribe buprenorphine or other MOUD (Medications for Opioid Use Disorder), assist with referrals to manage care for patients with OUD, detox services, MOUD used in detention facilities, MOUD used in Emergency Departments, alternative pain management providers, telehealth services, Federally Qualified Health Centers, Rural Health Centers, etc.
- THERAPEUTIC/RECOVERY SUPPORTS Therapeutic Services: Can include but are not limited to Licensed Addiction Counselors (LACs), Licensed Clinical Social Workers (LCSW), Licensed Clinical Professional (LCPC), Peer Support Specialist, telehealth therapeutic services, etc. who specifically treat individuals who misuse opioids (OUD and/or illicit use).

Recovery Services: Can include but are not limited to Recovery Residences, peer-ed support groups, drop-in centers, NA meetings, telehealth recovery services, etc.
